



And on the 8th day, G-d created Seniors.

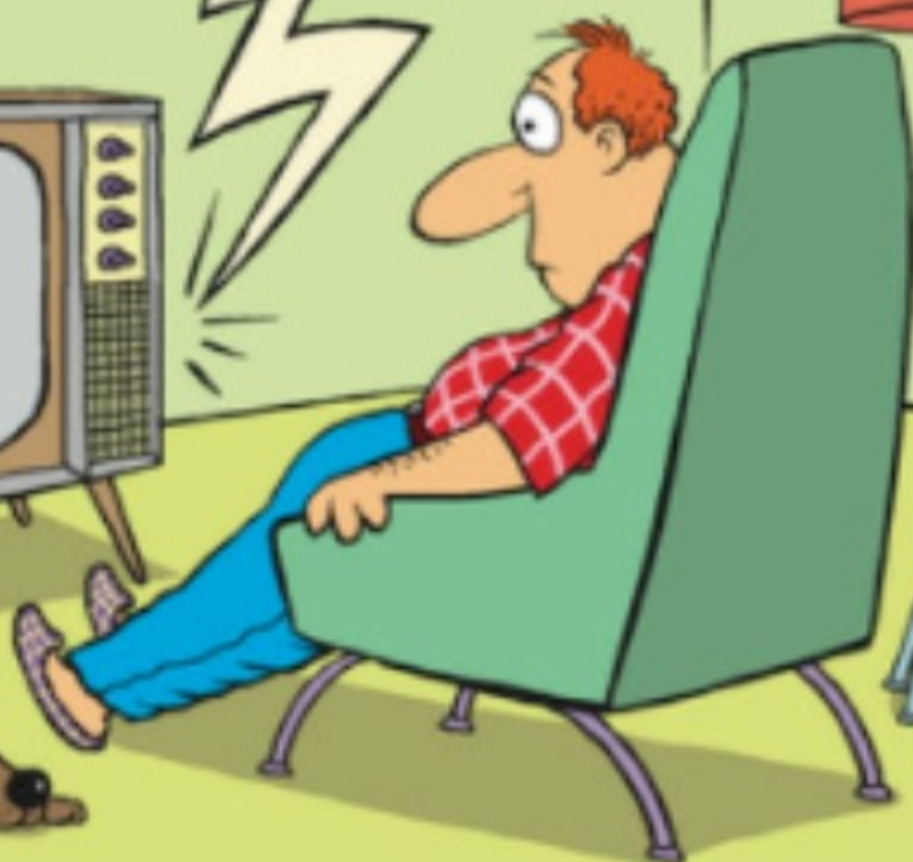
